Geometric representation theory (TBC)* Geordie Williamson (Max-Planck Institute for Mathematics)

The second week will comprise of research talks on these topics.

The goals of the workshop are twofold: on the one hand, we want to inspire the communication of state-of-the-art research within these flourishing areas and the exchange of ideas between them. On the other hand, we also want to give African postgraduates and researchers the opportunity to get in touch with international experts in order to help them enter one of these fields.
