Welcome to **Women in Red (WiR)**, a WikiProject whose objective is to turn "redlinks" into blue ones. That's why we are called "Women in Red". We recognized a need for this work as in October 2014 only 15.53% of the English Wikipedia's biographies were about women. Founded in July 2015, WiR strives to improve the figure, which has reached **18.09%** as of 4 November 2019. But that means, according to WHGI, only 301,743 of our 1,668,079 biographies are about women. Not impressed? "Content gender gap" is a form of systemic bias, and WiR addresses it in a positive way through shared values.

We take an inclusive view towards subject matter, editors, and language communities:

- Subject matter: If the subject of the article self-identifies as a woman—binary and/or non-binary and/or other—that person is included within the scope of Women in Red. Click on our **Redlinks index** to see our lists of missing articles by focus area, occupation and nationality. Like everything else on Wikipedia, this is incomplete, so feel free to add others which are pertinent to our scope (women's biographies, women's works, women's issues).
- Editors: We do not focus on the gender of the editor. Anyone/everyone is welcome to be a member, participant, enthusiast of Women in Red. If you participate in WiR, you can join up officially using the box in the top right-hand corner of this page. You are also welcome to add our userbox template `{{User WikiProject Women in Red}}` to your user page, to produce:

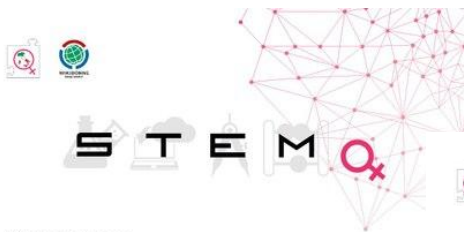

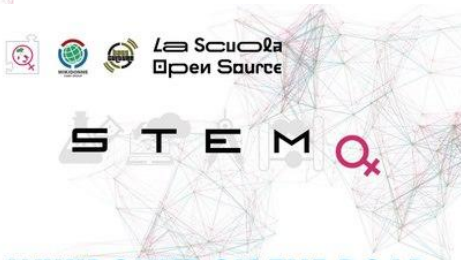

WikiProject Women is an effort to get every item about a woman described properly on Wikidata

- with the statements
 - istanza di (P31)=umano (Q5)
 - sezzo o genere (P21)=femmina (Q6581072)
 - occupazione (P106)= eg writer, painter, sculptor, judge, politician, scientist, *plus* any more specific occupations
 - data di nascita (P569)
 - luogo di nascita (P19)
 - at least one external identifier
- label/descriptions in 3 languages.

For a start, take a look at Gender Bias in Wikipedia and Britannica (Q27797614) and see also Wikidata:WikiProject Women/Number of women per occupation. You can now browse paintings of women by decade here: Wikidata:WikiProject Women/Portraits of women.

Lots of women were notable for just living to the ripe old age of 100. Their *occupazione* (P106), if they don't have one assigned, should be set to *centenario* (Q2944360). Please take a look at some of these women with at least 2 sitelinks who have no data di morte (P570) but were born before 1920:

Add P800 (notable works) to Women items [modifica]

To help increase overall quality of items about women, please add *opere rilevanti* (P800) to female items. For women sporters an olympic medal or other award. For women writers this could be a published work or important letter. For women inventors a patent. For scientists a discovery or other noted contribution. For actors a movie, play or TV show. For women artists this could be a work of art in a notable museum.

- Consider adding fashion items to *raffigura* (P180) on paintings of women, or add other attributes or activities depicted

The **Gender bias on Wikipedia** refers to the mismatch in the number of Wiki/mwedia contributors editing with a political or ideological bias regarding gender issues. It is a part of a larger diversity problem that the WMF attempts to address through sponsoring outreach efforts geographically as well as demographically, apparently under the assumption that recruiting editors with opposite bias will result in more neutral coverage (while actual Wikipedia policy would require editors to attempt bias-free contributions).

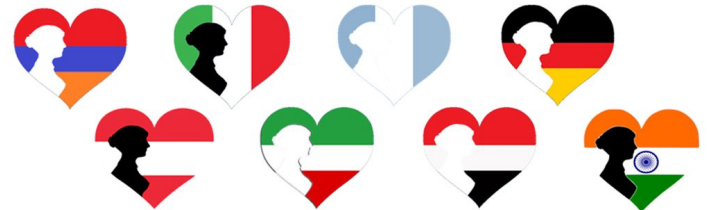

Katherine Louise Bouman (/ˈbaʊˈmæn/; born 1989/1990)^[1] is an American computer scientist working in the field of **imaging**. She was a member of the **Event Horizon Telescope** team that captured the first image of a black hole.^[2] In June 2019 she will join the faculty of **California Institute of Technology** as an assistant professor of computer and mathematical sciences.^[3]

Bouman grew up in **West Lafayette, Indiana** and graduated from **West Lafayette Junior-Senior High School** in 2007. Her father, **Charles Bouman**, is a professor of **chemical and computer engineering** and **biomedical engineering** at **Purdue University**.^[4] As a high school student she conducted imaging research at **Purdue University**.^[4] She first learned about the **Event Horizon Telescope** in school in 2007.^[5]

Bouman studied electrical engineering at the **University of Michigan** and graduated **summa cum laude** in 2011. She earned her master's degree (2013) and doctoral degree (2017) in electrical engineering and computer science from **Massachusetts Institute of Technology** (MIT).^[6]

At MIT, she was a member of the **Haystack Observatory**.^[8] She was supported by a **National Science Foundation** Graduate Fellowship. Her master's thesis, *Estimating Material Properties of Fabric through the Observation of Motion*,^[9] was awarded the **Ernst Guillemin Award** for best Master's Thesis.^[10] Her Ph.D. dissertation, *Extreme*
