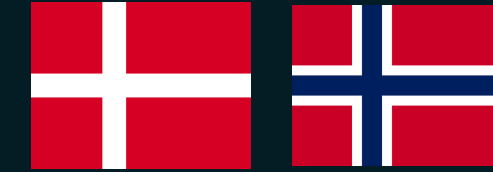
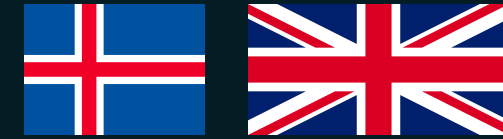
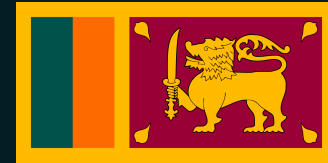

Why bother

Unless you work alone....

- Who does what and at what time?
- Who is responsible for ensuring that the pieces fit together?
- Who tests and validates
- Who....

Possible Roles

User experience designer

Some think that the UX designer only draws fancy user interfaces or designs pixel perfect wireframes, but in reality they define the entire user interaction with a system and ensure that user stories are connected, leading to one seamless user experience.

Technical lead

One person per team, per feature, or delivery who is responsible for the technical architecture, interfacing pieces, documentation, stability and robustness.

QA lead

One person per team, per feature, or delivery who is responsible for the quality. A person who nags developers when they identify issues, delay projects cause they find too much, but an invaluable team member who ensures successful deliveries on behalf of the team.

Next steps

Technical:
