- Cosmic strings
- String inspired alternatives to inflation
- Cosmological solutions in string theory
- Cosmological data VS string theory
- Future experimental observations

The main idea of the workshop is to highlight important new developments and problems and to stimulate discussion of these through a small number of daily talks and discussion sessions.
