Archaeoseism: Past Earthquakes Recorder by Man-made structure

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ARCHAEOSEISM: PAST EARTHQUAKES RECORDED BY MAN-MADE STRUCTURE

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- Radiation shock: fallen(originally) vertical elements (columns, walls)
- Radiation shaking: Dynamic trajectories
 - keystones, fractures, asperities
- Source: dislocated reference lines:
 - walls, floors, sea level
- Timing

 - monoliths: impact, fracture, footings
 - # fragmental
 - · walls
 - unidirectional collapse

DIRECTIONAL FALLING; OFFSET FROM DAMAGED PEDESTALS


