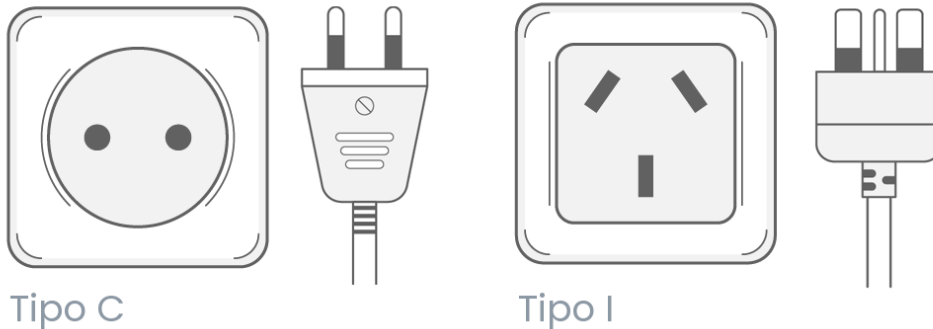




## TRAVEL, SAFETY and TOURISM information

While in some areas in Buenos Aires, try not to walk alone at night, do not use your cell phone while walking on the streets or on public transports (random belongings snatching is known to occur), and be aware of your surroundings.

In Argentina the common voltage is 220 V. The frequency is 50 Hz. The plugs and sockets are type C / I.



The currency of Argentina is the Argentine **Peso**, identified by the symbol \$ preceding the amount in the same way as many countries using peso or dollar currencies. There are many places where you can exchange money (currencies commonly accepted are USD, EURO and REALS), such as banks and exchange houses, but notice the exchange rates are usually very different and some places may offer preferred rates to non-argentinian residents. Credit cards are normally accepted, you should ask your bank about the exchange rate.

## HOW TO GET TO THE CITY FROM THE AIRPORTS

From EZEIZA Airport (Ministro Pistarini): Most international flights arrive at this airport

EZE airport is quite far from the city center. The simplest way is to use the “Remis” that are offered at the exit of the arrival gates where you can pay with your credit card or to take a taxi outside.

From AEROPARQUE (Jorge Newbery) Airport:

AEROPARQUE airport is close to the campus and either Taxi, UBER/CABIFY or public transportation are good options (see “How to get around the city” below).

## HOW TO GO AROUND THE CITY

- Public transportation: To use the public transportation it is necessary to buy a card called “SUBE”. To get this you can buy it at the subway stations. For the people staying at Play Hostel Arcos, the receptionist will have cards to sell (maybe not for everyone, but it can be shared).  
Once in the bus it is necessary to indicate the driver the destination so they can charge the price to pay with the SUBE card.

- Subway: This also works only with SUBE. You can get the map from: <https://emova.com.ar/index.php/accesibilidad/>
- UBER/CABIFY: For this you need to download the UBER/CABIFY app.

## HOW TO GET THE CAMPUS “PABELLÓN 1 CIUDAD UNIVERSITARIA”

By bus: Pabellon 1 is the first stop for all buses arriving at the campus, which are buses number 28, 33, 34B, 37A, 37B, 42, 45A, 45C, 45D, 107A, 160C, 160D, 160H, 166, 34  
 From Play Hostel Arcos, you can take bus 160, 37, 166, 34

The destination to be indicated to the bus driver is “**CIUDAD UNIVERSITARIA**”.

By Train: The train station of Belgrano Norte is named “Ciudad universitaria”. This station is in Pabellón III, from where you can walk to Pabellón I.
