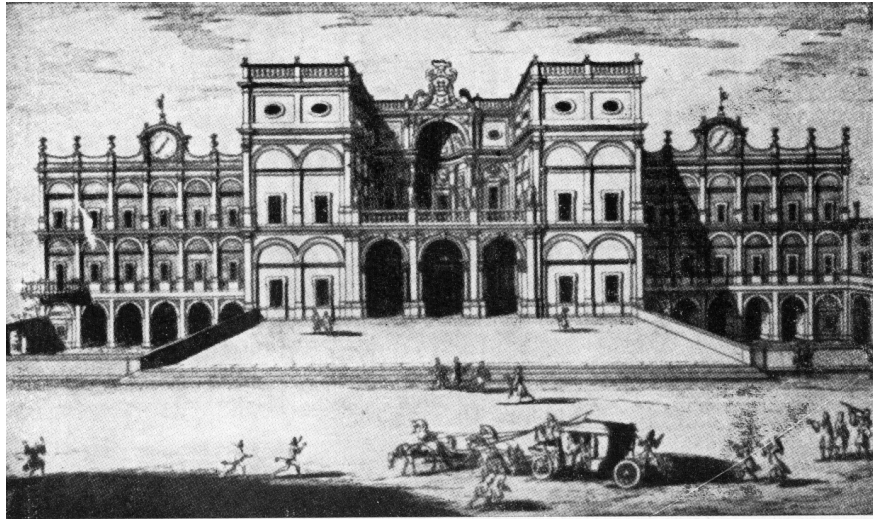


Isodarco



Isodarco started its activity in June 1966 organizing the first Course in Villa Falconieri in Frascati. In its first fifty-six years, Isodarco has organized 81 events: 60 courses (57 in Italy 1 in Germany, and 2 in North Cyprus), 5 special seminars (Amman, Venice, and 3 in Taipei), and 16 Seminars in China.

Isodarco

Isodarco provides expert knowledge in the field of arms control, international security, and nuclear weapons proliferation, with residential courses 6-10 days long where senior experts would teach and live together with people, young and senior, who are interested in understanding more about these problems.

The participants would include natural scientists, engineers, social and political scientists, journalists, junior diplomats, military people, and activists from the peace movement who want to play a more culturally and technically qualified role in their activity.

Sessions last 90 minutes, 45' for the presentation and 45' for the discussion. We organize four sessions a day leaving substantial free time for spontaneous intellectual or social activities offered by the participants, or some healthy physical exercise on the ski slopes.

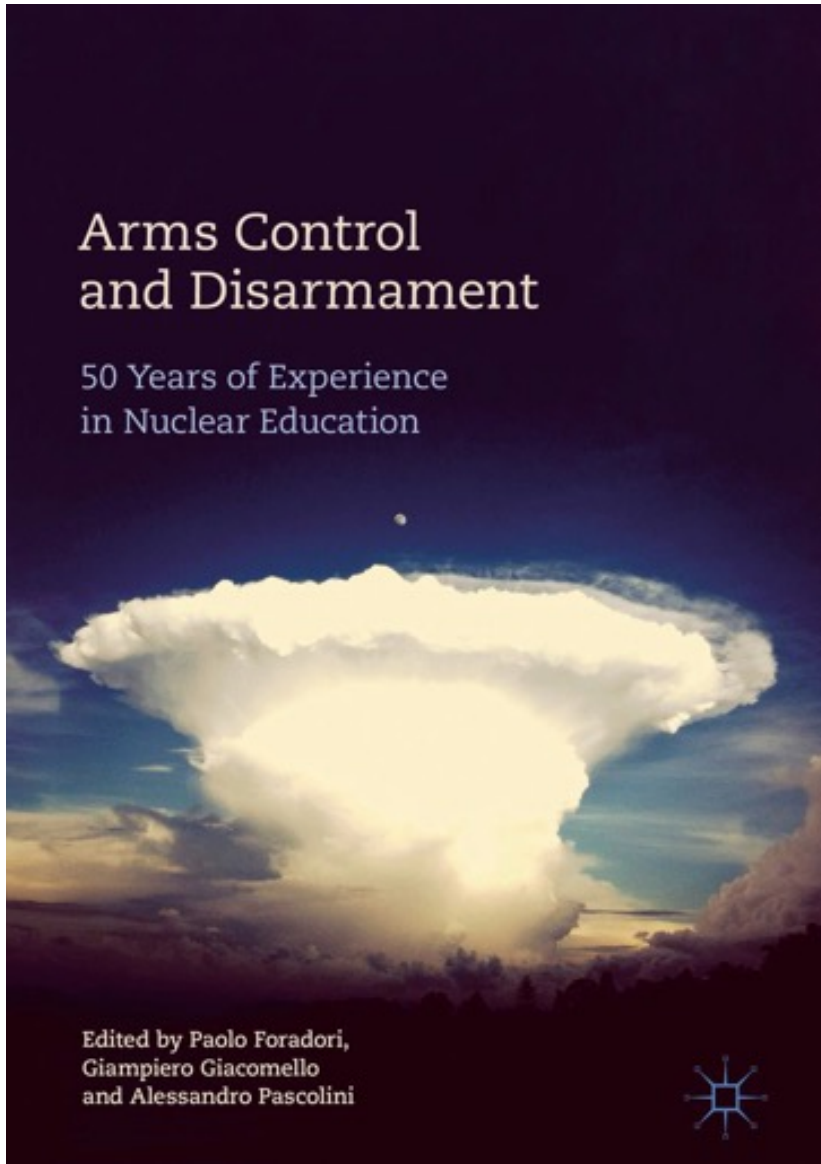

Twenty Years of Political Violence in Italy - 1969-1988

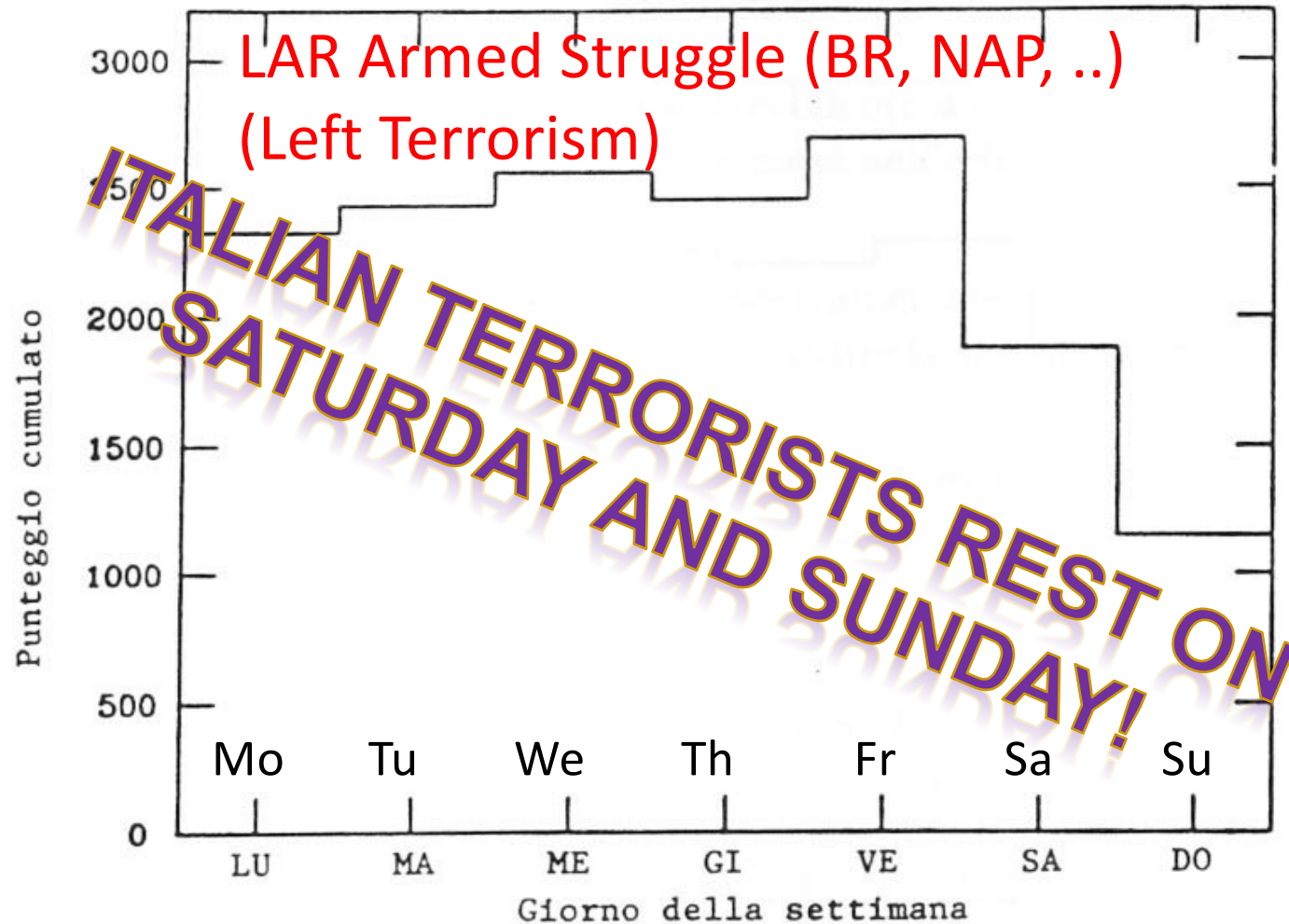
Chronology and Statistical Analysis

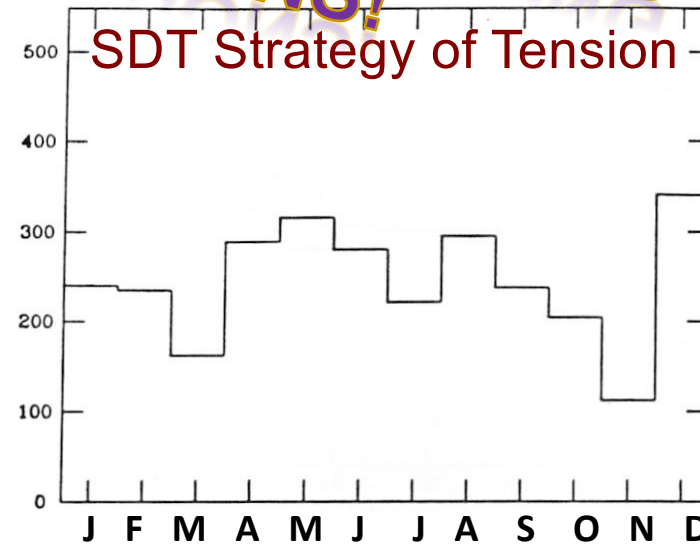
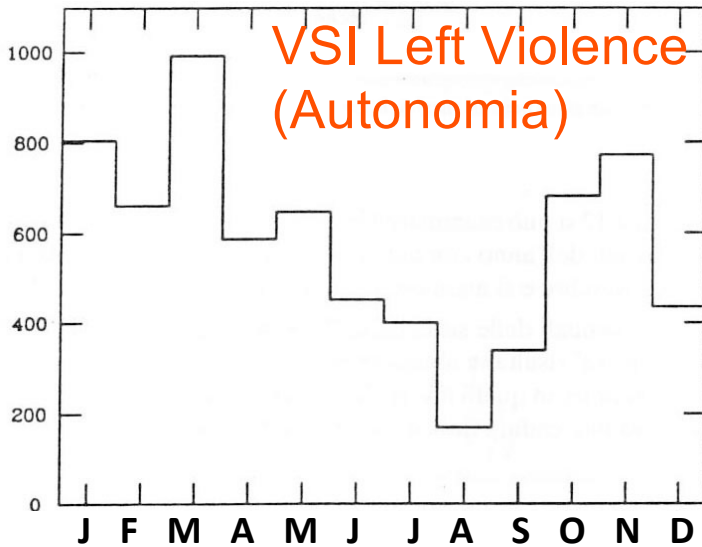
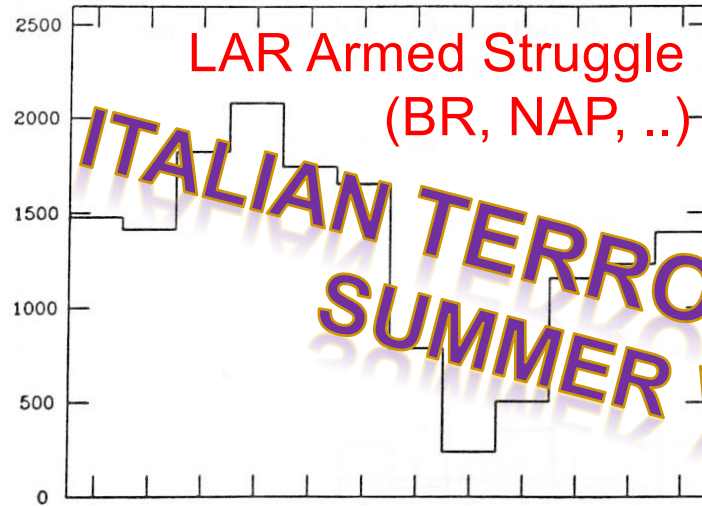
We analyzed 14,591 events of political violence, big and small, over a period of 20 years, divided them into 6 time series according to their political motivations, and submitted them to statistical analysis. Some peculiar results emerged.


