Located in Western Asia


Not universally recognized as a State

Background of Physics in Kurdistan – Iraq


Medical Physics is a brand new speciality for Kurdistan and Iraq – no schools of specialization





B. MODES OF COLLABORATION

The Participating Institutions shall endeavor to promote collaboration through a broad range of strategies, which in the initial stages of this cooperation shall include:

- 1. To improve international understanding;
- 2. To enhance the development of joint educational and research projects;
- 3. To increase individual educational opportunities;
- 4. Collaborative Research and Discovery, Learning and Teaching
- 5. Faculty exchanges for teaching and consultation (either unilateral or bilateral);
- 6. Cross-disciplinary research;
- 7. Proposal writing;
- Development and exchange of publications, library materials, data, and other teaching and research
 materials (Unless restricted by the laws and regulations of the partner institutions);
- 9. Study abroad;
- 10. Technical and scientific assistance;
- 11. Development of joint seminars, workshops, exhibitions and conferences;
- 12. Undergraduate student exchanges
- 13. Joint supervision of postgraduate student projects;
- 14. Language training;
- 15. Joint programs; and internships.
- 16. Other mutually agreed educational or research programs
- 17. The institutions try to identify and explore avenues for financial resources to support the academic interests and activities sponsored under this MOU.
- 18. To enrich the educational environment of all parties in the MOU;
- 19. To provide both societies with more and better information about the other party.

Before implementing these activities, the parties will discuss the opportunities and challenges presented and will thereafter enter into specific activity agreements based on the mutually agreed objectives and
