Gang Tian is Chair Professor at Peking University and Director of the Beijing International Center for Mathematical Research. He has made fundamental contributions to geometric analysis, complex geometry and symplectic geometry. He received the Alan T. Waterman Award and the Oswald Veblen Prize, and was twice invited to speak at the ICM. He is a member of the Chinese Academy of Sciences and the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.



Cristina Trombetti is Full Professor of Mathematical Analysis at the University of Naples Federico II and President of the Italian National Institute for Advanced Mathematics (INdAM). Her research focuses on partial differential equations, calculus of variations, shape optimization, and functional and geometric inequalities. She is the author of about 90 scientific publications and has held several academic and institutional leadership positions.



Hongliang Zhang, Director, Division of Asia, Africa and International Organizations, Bureau of International Cooperation, National Natural Science Foundation of China (NSFC) Hongliang Zhang heads the Division of Asia, Africa and International Organizations. He holds his MD degree from Jilin University, China, and his PhD degree from Karolinska Institute, Sweden. From 2012 to 2016, he was a neurologist and neuroscientist (associate chief physician and associate professor) at Jilin University, Changchun, China. His research interests are neuroimmunological disorders with emphasis on Guillain-Barré syndrome. In 2016, he joined NSFC and currently he is working at the Bureau of International Cooperation, NSFC.
