

Lucia Caporaso was born and raised in Roma, Italy. She got her undergraduate degree from Sapienza University (Roma), in 1989 and her Ph.D. in mathematics from Harvard University (Cambridge - USA) in 1993. She is a full professor at Roma Tre University since 2001.

Her main research interests are in algebraic geometry, but she is also interested in the connections of algebraic geometry with arithmetic geometry and combinatorics.

She has more than forty papers about the theory of algebraic curves, their jacobians and their moduli spaces, about the distribution of rational points on algebraic varieties, and about tropical and non-archimedean geometry.

She has delivered more sixty invited lectures at international conferences, among which the ECM in 1997 and the ICM in 2018.
