The Joint ICTP-IAEA Nuclear Stakeholder Engagement School is a 5-day training course designed to enhance understanding and raise awareness of stakeholder engagement as an essential element of a complete nuclear power programme.

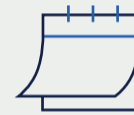
## MORE INFORMATION:

For a nuclear energy project to be successful, stakeholder engagement must be embedded in the organizational management processes and its core values. Engagement needs to start at an early stage of the project and continue throughout the nuclear fuel cycle and the life cycle of nuclear facilities. A well-established stakeholder engagement strategy that includes tools for seeking out, listening to and acting upon various stakeholder views, is essential. Such an approach is a prerequisite for a sustainable nuclear energy project and enhances public confidence in the decision making process.

- Psychology of human decision making and stakeholder engagement;
- Tools, methods and approaches to effective stakeholder engagement;
- Stakeholder engagement strategy and plan;
- Roles and responsibilities in stakeholder engagement;
- Leadership and influencing skills;
- Crisis and emergency communication;
- Public information and communication;
- Community engagement;
- Disinformation, misinformation, rumours and fake news mitigation;
- Ensuring sustained stakeholder engagement.

Applicants are required to submit a motivational video as part of the selection process.
