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Preparation

Check the physical location, from front, back, sides Check audio visual connections and effectiveness Know your audience Organise slides to be logical Variety, pictures more memorable than words Practice, mirror, video yourself





Introduce yourself Dress appropriately Sound spontaneous Be enthusiastic Be conversational and interact with audience Be careful about your body language Respect local culture and tradition



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Have an effective introduction-capture the attention Do not read your slides Face the audience Engage with a few individuals Have an effective conclusion Use B & W

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Judging Criteria

Idea, Innovation and IP

(Clear and well-understood description of the product or service)

Business Model

(How do you make money? Various elements of the business model are clearly understood)

Team and Teamwork

(Team effort as evidenced during the 4 days of the workshop and has/or identified needed skills, contacts and experience)

Finance

(The financial plan is reasonable, specific funding requirement and potential return on investment are identified)

Presentation

(Quality of slides, utilisation of time & team members, responses)





Must haves, essentials

Present in English **Powerpoint slides in English** Present in 10 minutes Amount of cash required % of the Company offered Potential return on investment **Preparedness for Q & A (10 minutes)**





Equity Investment opportunity

"A amount of cash" for **"B % of the shares"** (equity) of the company.

A return on investment of "N" amount of cash within 5 years where N amount of cash is X times "A amount of cash" Replace bold items with your numbers

Solution

ABEC 50 Liter bioreactor. In comparison, biosynthesis can allow facilities to be used for the production of a variety of compounds, simply by swapping the organism being grown within the bioreactor.
