
In this visualization, we map projects addressing the gender gap by language and country or region within a country.





Welcome to Women in Red (WIR), a WikiProject whose objective is to turn "redlinks" into blue ones. That's why we are called "Women in Red". We recognized a need for this work as in October 2014 only 15.53% of the English Wikipedia's biographies were about women. Founded in July 2015, WIR strives to improve the figure, which has reached **18.09%** as of 4 November 2019. But that means, according to WHG10, only 301,743 of our 1,668,079 biographies are about women. Not impressed? "Content gender gap" is a form of systemic bias, and WIR addresses it in a positive way through shared values.

We take an inclusive view towards subject matter, editors, and language communities:

- Subject matter: If the subject of the article self-identifies as a woman—binary and/or non-binary and/or other—that person is included within the scope of Women in Red. Click on our [Redlinks index](#) to see our lists of missing articles by focus area, occupation and nationality. Like everything else on Wikipedia, this is incomplete, so feel free to add others which are pertinent to our scope (women's biographies, women's works, women's issues).
- Editors: We do not focus on the gender of the editor. Anyone/everyone is welcome to be a member, participant, enthusiast of Women in Red. If you participate in WIR, you can join up officially using the box in the top right-hand corner of this page. You are also welcome to add our userbox template {{User WikiProject Women in Red}} to your user page, to produce:



- Language communities: While Women in Red began on English Wikipedia, it is an international commitment with dozens of other language communities. Please add a link to your language's coordination page [here](#).

The Gender bias on Wikipedia refers to the mismatch in the number of Wikipedia contributors editing with a political or ideological bias regarding gender issues. It is a part of a larger diversity problem that the WMF attempts to address through sponsoring outreach efforts geographically as well as demographically, apparently under the assumption that recruiting editors with opposite bias will result in more neutral coverage (while actual Wikipedia policy would require editors to accept bias-free contributions).



Early life and education

Bouman grew up in West Lafayette, Indiana. She graduated from West Lafayette Junior-Senior High School in 2007. Her father, Charles Bouman, is a professor of **chemical and computer engineering** and biomedical engineering at Purdue University.^[4] As a high school student, she conducted imaging research at her father's university.^[4] She first learned about the Event Horizon Telescope in school in 2007.^[5]

Bouman studied electrical engineering at the University of Michigan and graduated **summa cum laude** in 2011. She earned her master's degree (2013) and doctoral degree (2017) in electrical engineering and computer science from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT).^[6]

At MIT, she was a member of the Haystack Observatory.^[8] She was supported by a National Science Foundation Graduate Fellowship. Her master's thesis, *Estimating Material Properties of Fabric through the Observation of Motion*,^[9] was awarded the Ernst Guillemin Award for best Master's Thesis.^[10] Her Ph.D. dissertation, *Extreme*
