A Miniworkshop on "Frontiers in Advanced Materials" will be held at the Abdus Salam International Centre for Theoretical Physics (ICTP) in Trieste, Italy, from 15 to 19 May 2001. A group of faculty members from the Materials Research Laboratory at the University of California, Santa Barbara (UCSB), will participate (see see list below). The themes of the activity will include (i) Structural and inorganic materials, (ii) Biomolecular materials, (iii) Conducting polymers, and (iv) Theory and modeling in materials science.

Scientists from developing countries are encouraged to apply. The Miniworkshop is part of a planned UCSB series, with the next one to be held in Latin America in 2002.

The activity is open to scientists from all member countries of the United Nations, UNESCO or IAEA. Although the main purpose of the Abdus Salam ICTP is to help researchers from developing countries through a programme based on international co-operation, students and post-doctoral scientists from developed countries are also welcome to attend. The activity will be conducted in English. There is no registration fee.

Limited funding (including travel grants) for participation in the activity is available, mostly for applicants from developing countries. It is stressed that participants whose travel expenses are paid by the ICTP

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are required to attend the entire activity.

The deadline for submitting requests for participation is 1 March 2001.
