Some history

EUnet began in April 1982
run and used by Unix specialists
using existing software (uucp, news)
and interconnected with similar
US networking.

The user community has changed
much influenced by

- acceptance and success of Unix
- availability of gateways and integration
of services with other networks
- establishment of networking based
communications in DP industries and
scientific world

technical development

- start with telephone modems
(in the old times 300 or 1200 Bd)
- drop in X.25 with Triple-X
(usually with hardware PAD)
- optimize protocol for X.25
- drop in leased lines
- switch to IP
- use better modems on uucp links

expected

- ISDN for uucp
- ISDN for IP
- ISO IP (CLNS)
- frame relay
- high speed
- ...

International backbone

structure prompted by high costs
of crossing borders

backbone consists of
one backbone site per country
