The Abdus Salam International Centre for Theoretical Physics, Trieste, Italy, in co-operation with the Department of Theoretical Physics of the University of Trieste is organizing a follow-up of the previous series of Workshops on 'Web Enabling Technologies' held at ICTP. The focus of the new 2005 Workshop is a more exclusive reference to 'e-Learning issues and related Open Source technologies', emphasizing the transfer of information and up-to-date technologies and solutions from the IT community to the potential content provider in the scientific community.

The Workshop Directors are Dr. E. Canessa and Dr. G. Pastore.

### MOTIVATION

The plethora of (less-known) Open Source technologies can offer to the Scientific Community of Developing Countries concrete alternatives to enter the Internet and to share their contents and resources with their peers world-wide. This lack of knowledge indicates the need for the academic environment to be trained in Information and Open Source Web Technologies as well as in the different strategies for scientific e-Learning to optimize its usage and contents.

The motivation of a new Web Enabling Workshop focusing on scientific e-Learning and related issues is to target scientists working in remote areas under low-bandwidth conditions. The means used to write and share scientific knowledge and ideas, with their own unique professional needs, are essential to help reduce scientific isolation. The aim is to guide Scientists to become acquainted with the resources available for this purpose and help to reduce the digital divide.

The growth of the Internet in the Universities in developing countries has to face two problems:

- limited bandwidth of available telecommunication lines, causing line congestion and making access exceedingly slow, often beyond the limits of usability;
- insufficient computer literacy of the academic community, with the consequent insufficient understanding of the potential of the network as a tool for *spreading* information (contrasted with its use for *accessing* information generated elsewhere), promoting collaboration and enhancing knowledge transfer.

Both problems reduce drastically the effectiveness of Internet access as a tool to overcome scientific isolation. Moreover, emphasizing passive access only, with respect to an active diffusion and contents of information as the only purpose of the Internet reduces its usefulness for national development.

## **PURPOSE**

With respect to the previous edition, the focus of the 2005 Workshop will shift to a more exclusive reference to "e-Learning issues and Open Source technologies", and emphasizing the transfer of information about up-to-date technologies and solutions from the IT community to the potential content provider in the scientific community.

This new Workshop aims to train and inform trainers at scientific and academic institutions about the *state-of-the-art* of Web-based technologies for e-Learning, new standards, services and developments specifically tailored to the scientific formation and support at distance using the Internet. The purpose is to allow the workshop participants to act mainly as teachers, but also as consultants, to their national community, colleagues and students.

The Workshop objectives point to familiarize participants with basic and advanced tools to put and search scientific information on a multicultural Web, administration of e-learning CMS selected among those most relevant to the kind of materials that scientists need to distribute (scientific papers & data, courseware ...).

## **PROGRAMME**

The Workshop will consist of:

- *Technicalities:* Web Servers/Software, Statistical Tools and User Tracking, etc.
- *Web Access to Resources:* e-Learning open source packages, databases and related issues.
- *Applications:* Authoring/Page design/Web Site tools, CGI's, Servlets, Collaborative and e-Learning Environments, Chat Rooms/Web Conferencing, Didactic Web Presentations, Scientific e-Publishing. Scientific Web notation like MathML and key technical developments like XML.
- *Cases Studies by Participants.*

Part of the Workshop will consist of laboratory sessions and demos. Linux will be used as primary O.S.

## **PARTICIPATION**

This new Workshop aims to train and inform trainers at scientific and academic institutions about the state-of-the-art of Web-based technologies for e-Learning, new standards, services and developments specifically tailored to the Scientific formation and support at distance using the Internet. The purpose is to allow the workshop participants to act mainly as teachers, but also as consultants, to their national community, colleagues and students.

The Workshop is open to scientists from countries that are members of the UN, UNESCO or IAEA. The main purpose of The Abdus Salam ICTP is to help research workers from developing countries within a framework of international cooperation, a limited number of students and post-doctoral scientists from developed countries are also welcome to attend. The Workshop is also targeted to Decision Makers and Computer Consultants working in isolated scientific environments with a minimal infrastructure.

Only limited funds are available for participants from developing countries who will be selected by the Organizers. May be requested only by candidates who are nationals of, and working in, a developing country, and who are not more than 45 years old. **Every effort should be made by candidates to secure support for their fares (or at least half-fare) from their home country.** It is stressed that participants whose travel expenses are paid by the ICTP are required to attend the entire Workshop. There is no registration fee to be paid. For both technical reasons and limited resources the total attendance to this Workshop is strictly limited to a few participants. As the Workshop will be conducted in English, participants should have an adequate working knowledge of that language.
