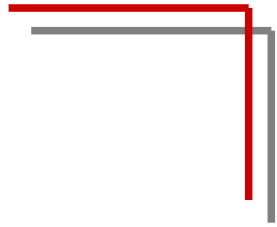


Problems encountered in Virtual Box installation



Common Problems: Packages Selection

- Some packages (typically GUI) are missing after installation
 - Reinstallation (bad option, but useful)
 - Installation of missing packages using yum

yum groupinstall Desktop

yum groupinstall “X Window System” (note the quotes)

Edit /etc/inittab and change id:3:initdefault to 5. Reboot the system.

From GUI

Go to System → Administration → Add/Remove Software

Common Problems: Network

- You cannot reach the outside network
 - Go to System → Preferences → Network Connections
 - Select “System eth0” and go to “edit”
 - Check “connect automatically”
 - Apply modifications

Common Problems: Strange Virtualbox Behavior

- Sometimes Virtualbox pauses for unknown reason
 - Check if you Virtual Machine is on the local hard disk (/scratch) and not on you home directory.

Common Problems: 64 bit problems

- Your Centos 6 installation hangs at the beginning with something like “64 bit system needed”
 - Check if your VM version is “Red Hat 64bit”
 - If it is, check in your BIOS settings if “Hardware Virtualization” is enabled (the label defers on different systems)
